 - Why you want to attend Billings Catholic Schools.
 - Please explain why you feel you are a good candidate to receive this scholarship.
2. Enclose a copy of your most recent report card or transcript.
3. Enclose one letter of recommendation from a non-relative who can attest to your academic, personal and spiritual activities. Each letter should include the person's name and their relationship to you.
