Gabby's little brother, David, is a little lamb at St. Francis Early Childhood Preschool. Like his big sister, competition seems to be in his veins as he constantly throws or kicks a ball. If David is doing anything else, it is wrestling his sister Gabby. "It's causing me grey hair," admits Jessica.

As for her, Jessica's passion and career are early childhood. Through her work, she has expanded afterschool and preschool care for children of low-income families in Billings. Jessica is currently the assistant director for Buttons and Bows Childcare ensuring high-quality care of 124 children. Her programs consistently receive top marks by the MT Department of Public Health and Human Services.

In speaking about why she chose Billings Catholic Schools, Jessica reflected, "I never seriously

considered Catholic schools until I took a tour of Billings Central through a leadership training course. It opened my eyes and my heart. 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INCREDIBLE RENEWAL, BECAUSE OF YOU!

Summer is a time of renewal for students and families. This past summer, your Billings Catholic Schools were undergoing a renewal of its own! Because of you – our Billings Catholic Schools Family – our schools, its students, and parents are reaping a rich harvest of the seeds you planted with your contributions this past year! Below are a few ways you made a difference:

Eyes in the Sky: For our littlest lambs – the preschoolers of St. Francis Early Childhood – safety is the utmost concern. To increase our care of the littlest ones, 8 additional cameras were installed in and around the facility. These "eyes in the sky" ensure the safety of entrances, the playground, and outside areas. Not only can we see every "boo-boo," but we keep vigilant watch around our early childhood center.

For the Whole Student: This past year, St. Francis installed new "sensory paths" to better engage the entire students' body, mind, and soul. Think of these sensory paths as enhanced hopscotch with pictures and lessons. One path teaches students to pray the rosary, another explores the solar system, and another discovers nature. For students who have the wiggles, a place to hop, stretch, jump, and skip helps the students...and their teachers!

Take a Seat!: In the past few years, Colton Field has been nurtured and groomed for our student-athletes. Its grass turf is as well manicured as any field. But without any bleachers, parents and grandparents had to watch their students from the sidelines. A grassroots campaign to raise \$25,000 to purchase a 10 row, 33-foot-long set of bleachers for Colton Field was achieved. Inspired by this effort, another BCS Family member stepped forward to match! Finally, our student athletes can find their parents and grandparents in the bleachers – cheering their Rams to victory!

Excellence in Academics: By 4th grade, students transition from learning to read to reading to learn. In the classroom, students read lengthier chapter books as a class, discussing its ideas and content. New classroom novel sets were purchased for each of our 4th grade classrooms. At Billings Central Catholic, a new Anatomy and Physiology class will inspire medical aspirations

of students as they interact with anatomical models, organ simulators, and use medical equipment such as stethoscopes, blood pressure cuffs, and suturing kits.

STEM Curriculum: Through your gifts to this year's Mayfair Special Project, you impact every student in the schools with enhanced science and technology. Students will create with a new 3D and laser printer, experience careers in virtual reality through an Oculus headset, explore with sand and water tables, refresh the greenhouse with supplies, code with robotics equipment, and so much more!

ELEVATING: Billings Central Catholic students will ELEVATE with a new elevator for those in need, an expanded parking lot that doubles the number of parking spots, and added lighting and safety features for our students, teachers, and staff. Because of your generosity, this \$1.4 million project is nearly complete.

Tuition Assistance Funds: Our Catholic Schools are bursting with an increasing number of students enrolled in our schools. Why?
