### FUTURE LEADER: CHRISTIAN KAY -NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP SEMI-FINALIST

Christian Kay has been a Student of our Billings Catholic Schools since kindergarten. He's now a senior at Central and has just been announced a National Merit Semifinalist. "The whole process has been exciting," said Christian. "I wasn't going into it expecting to become a semifinalist."

Gaining recognition as a National Merit Semifinalist is a prestigious achievement. To become a semifinalist, test takers must score in the top 1% on the PSAT in their state. The next steps to becoming a finalist include submitting high school transcripts, a letter or letters of recommendation, and a personal essay.

Christian attributes his inspiration to Mr. Fairbanks and Mr. Pierson. Both have written letters of recommendation for him. "They inspire me with their energy and are passionate about what they do," said Christian. "Small class sizes and the dedication of my teachers are reasons why a Catholic education has prepared me for college." Last year, Christian received the Ann Millikan Memorial Scholarship through the Billings Catholic Schools Foundation. Requirements are that recipients must have a 3.0 GPA and be involved in extra

curricular activities. Involvement is something Christian knows a thing or two about. He is a member of the cross-country team as a team captain, lifeguards in the summer at the Yellowstone Country Club and is a participant in the Montana Science Olympiad. The generosity of you, our donors ensures that students like Christian, are afforded the opportunity to be a part of the Catholic School community and have access to dedicated teachers, smaller class sizes and faith formation to help shape a well-rounded individual for life after high school.

Christian plans on studying biology & chemistry and is considering the field of premed. He has already applied to MSU Bozeman (parents Josh and Katie are alumni) and is also considering applying to Carrol College. He has a younger brother, Caleb who is a 7th grader at St. Francis.

When asked what advice he would give to other students preparing to go to college, Christian replied, "It is important to start looking into schools as early as you can. And lean on your teachers for help".
